

- 3<sup>rd</sup>....1898- Lt Dion Williams & Marines From USS Baltimore Raised the American flag over Cavite City, Phillipines
- 6<sup>th</sup> ....1942-The colors of the 4thMarRegt were burned to Avoid capture on Corregidor
- 13th...1846- War was declared against Mexico
- 15<sup>th</sup>...1862- Cpl John Mackie became the first Marine awarded The Medal of Honor
- 20<sup>th</sup>...1906-Maj John A Lejeune embarked his battalion for Duty in Panama
- 25<sup>th</sup>...1775- Eight Marines escorted payroll; This was the first recorded action of the Continental Marines
- 28<sup>th</sup>...1945-The 5<sup>th</sup>MarRegt began the final assault against Shuri Castle, Okinawa
- 30<sup>th</sup>...1949-3<sup>rd</sup> Marines, last Marines to leave Shanghai, China During May and arrived in San Diego, CA

#### Treasure Valley Young Marines


