
Coffee Klatch

Marines Eligible for Purple Heart

Week of May 09, 2011

Stars and Stripes reports that under a new fleet-wide instruction, Marines who retain consciousness after a concussion may now receive the Purple Heart medal if diagnosed by a medical officer as not fit for full duty "due to persistent signs, symptoms, or findings of functional impairment for a period greater than 48 hours from the time of the concussive incident." The new instruction may affect thousands of troops who have served in battle since Sept. 11, 2001. Previously, only injuries that required medical treatment were eligible for a Purple Heart. Benefit Checks Go Electronic

VA benefits checks will soon be a thing of the past. The U.S. Department of the Treasury recently announced that as of May 1, anyone applying for Social Security, VA or other federal benefits will need to choose an electronic payment method because paper checks will no longer be an option. Additionally, people currently receiving federal benefits by check, including payments from the VA, must switch to direct deposit by March 1, 2013. Information about the change in the delivery of benefit payments, as well as application procedures, are posted on the federal Go Direct website. Assistance is also being offered by the U.S. Treasury Electronic Payment Solution Center for free at (800) 333-1795.

VA to Issue Debit Cards

Week of May 16, 2011

The Department of Veterans Affairs (through the Treasury Department) will offer beneficiaries without bank accounts the option to enroll in the Direct Express debit card program with Comerica Bank. Direct Express payments will be directly deposited into that account and made accessible through a debit card. Personal funds cannot be transferred into this account as it can only be used to receive Federal benefits. Direct Express card ⇒ ⇒

House Committee Okay's TRICARE

Increase

Week of May 16, 2011

Last week the House Armed Services Committee gave the go ahead for the Obama administration's plan to begin to raise out-of-pocket costs modestly for working-age retirees TRICARE beneficiaries. This would be the first increase in TRICARE Prime enrollment fees in more than 15 years. If approved the committee's budget bill would allow DoD to increase premiums by \$30 a year for individual coverage and \$60 a year for family coverage. The HAS defense budget would also allow DoD to raise the TRICARE Prime premium on an annual basis, but not at the rate they requested.

Retiree COLA Increase Looks Likely

Week of May 23, 2011

According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, the Consumer Price Index for April is up 0.8 percent over the March CPI. This is important for military retirees, and those drawing VA benefits, because the CPI is used to determine the annual cost-of-living-adjustment (COLA) and rate adjustments to VA Disability and Compensation, Vets Pension, and other VA rates for the following year. The Military Officers Association of America (MOAA) reports that the April 2011 CPI is up 2.9% from the 2008 CPI, which means retirees may see a COLA increase in 2012, the first since 2008


